### Biography

Kingston is pleased to welcome Paul Gipe and to hear his informative talk on **Wind Energy**. His extensive knowledge on the subject of Wind Energy will surely inform and educate the audience at **St. Lawrence College on January 26<sup>th</sup>**.

Paul has been involved with Wind Energy since 1976 and is best known for his advocacy of Wind Energy lecturing widely in Europe, North America and the South Pacific.

Honoured in 1998 by the World Energy Congress – he was designated a **“pioneer in renewable energy”** and was also named by the American Wind Energy Association (AWEA) as the **“industry's person of the year”**.

His publishing successes include: **“Wind Energy Comes of Age”** selected by the American Association of College and Research libraries for its list of outstanding academic books, and **“Wind Power in View: Energy Landscapes in a Crowded World”** an authoritative international collaboration on the siting of wind energy facilities.

Other publishing accomplishments include numerous articles for both the popular and trade press – accompanied by his superior photography on the subject.

Paul Gipe is presently Acting Executive director of Ontario Sustainable Energy Association, a contributing editor to “WindStats Newsletter, and currently a member of the Sierra Club's technical advisory team on energy.
